## **COLLEGE FAIRS**

Often held in high school gyms, a college fair is typically a students' first connection with the University. These events are usually well attended and give students and families an opportunity to learn about the admissions process, majors and campus life.

### **RECEPTIONS**

Stony Brook hosts a number of off campus events throughout the year which allow us to meet with students in their home state.

Theses are typically held 2 times during the year; in the Fall as an Information Session for prospective students and in the Spring as a Yield Reception for admitted students.

### **CONNECTIONS**

# COLLEGE FAIRS

During the year, the Admissions Office hosts events across the country for prospective and admitted students and their families.
